

How 10 Books A Home Teaches Learners English

During 10BH's April Parent Conferences, 27% of Participants said that 10BH has helped their child to learn English. Their comments were in response to this question: What have you seen that helps you know the program is working for your child?

I believe that her interest in learning English grew tremendously!! She would be too shy before that she would barely speak to anyone especially strangers. When she started preschool she had two teachers one in English and one in Spanish. She would not want to be around her English teacher during preschool and would tell me to get her out. After enrolling with 10BH her confidence in English increased and I am so happy that she is more independent and faces her fears more when she feels uncomfortable.

He can now write his name, abcs, numbers 1-13. Before he started the program he did not speak any English and now with lessons he speaks a lot of english! He can communicate with Annie and understands what she asks from him.

I am proud of Dana over all! I can tell you that instead of grabbing her tablet when I get home she picks up a books and "doesn't ask me" but tells me to read it to her. I find it amazing how much she can do and it has been less than a year with 10BH. Her English is getting better although she mixes it with Spanish sometimes she tries to speak full sentences in English.

When he started he didn't know anything. I didn't know how to help him and now he knows his abc, numbers 1-20, and he speaks very good English with Becky.

I could see all the progress he has made with Anu. I would try to do activities with him but I know its not the same as having a teacher. Raymond already knows how to write his name, knows how to cut without any problem, knows how to count 1-100, his colors and his vocabulary in English has increased tremendously!

The progress that I am the most happy with is that he speaks more English! I can hear him having conversations with his older sisters who are 13 and 8. He tries his best to speak only English!

When I first enrolled Daniel with 10BH he had speech therapy, they had done an IEP and his results in speech and academics were at 5%. After two years of therapy and one year of lessons with 10BH he has progressed and he is at 85%. He has learned how to express himself when he wants something and even though he cuts words out he is pushing though to speak more in English. I am really proud of him not giving up and willing to let go of his frustration when he cannot communicate with me. He will start TK this fall and I can't wait to see how much I will be able to help him and knowing he will have another year of lessons only gets me excited!

He goes to a spanish school in Palo Alto and I've noticed that he has learned a lot of English through Chris every lesson. I am very happy to have Chris because she has taught him so much that I know he does not do at school. He knows his numbers, letters, and enjoys reading during and outside of lessons.

Jennifer has really advanced with preschool and having lessons. Her English comprehension has increased a lot. Even though she does not speak much English I know she understands because she does everything Mathew asks her to do.

She has learned English through 10BH and I'm very excited because at school they tell me she is the most advanced in the class. I am thankful for Emma because she teaches her something different every lesson.

During her participation with the program she learned a lot of English and her passion for reading and writing has increased. Most of all she enjoys doing math problems and looks forward for school everyday.

I can honestly say that I am proud of him for being able to read 2-3 pages out of a book !! His English has progressed a lot and I can't wait to continue to further support him.

I was really happy with the first lesson. He enjoys all the activites done! The teacher was very patient with Diego and myself even though English was tough for us.

I could tell that she has progressed. She understands more English and knows how to count with her fingers. She always looks forward to see Janet when Mondays comes she asks me is my teacher here?. I know this program is helping her because she is getting individual attention and is around kids in school.

We are always happy to see Mercedes. She is very patient with Lupita and shows how much she cares for her. She always comes with new activities and I can tell that motivates Lupita to stay engaged during lessons and to remember what was covered the previous lessons. She knows her abcs, numbers, and shapes. Mercedes always encourages Lupita to speak in English.

He knows his ABC, numbers 1-20, his English vocabulary has expanded and at home he tries to only speak English with his brother even though we only speak spanish at home.

I see that 10BH and preschool has helped her academically. She knows her letters, colors, and shapes. Although she doesn't speak much English I can tell that she understands it!

During the last three sessions, the teacher has helped Emanuel practice the ABC's. He has learned how to distinguish letters and how to pronounce words in English. Emanuel took a while to start talking and that affected his speech development. With his teacher's help he has been able to pronunciate more words in English. The teacher is specifically helping him to slow down when speaking. Emanuel has learned how to pronounce a few words that he pronounced incorrectly. One of them being the word good. His teacher is also very understanding and flexible. For example, when he asked Emanuel to write his name in a straight line. At that moment, Emanuel started crying and his teacher told him not to worry and that he was doing good job. This was helpful to Emanuel because he kept practicing this skill and greatly improved it.

I am really proud of him because he recognizes more letters and numbers. His English conversations are longer now!. Leo loves Roger, he is always punctual and shows how much he is into the lessons.

He has progressed in many areas like comprehension, numbers 1-100, identifying letters, English language, and behavior. He now knows how to expressive himself and tells me what he feels, what he wants, etc. I am really happy to see how advanced he is at his age and how motivated he is to want to learn.
